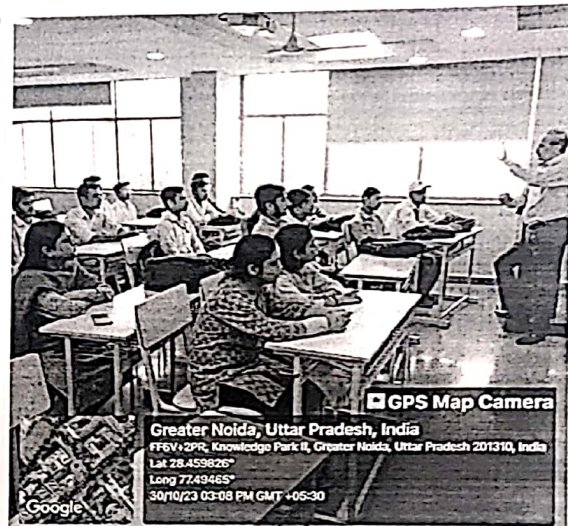
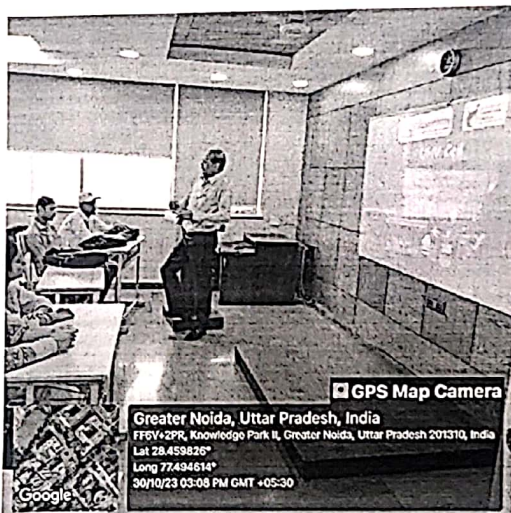
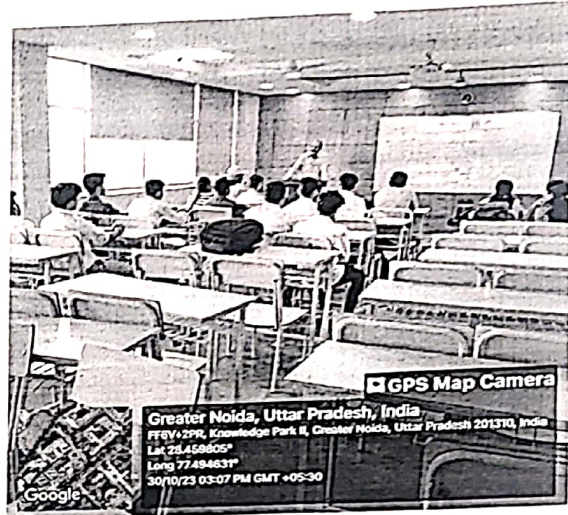
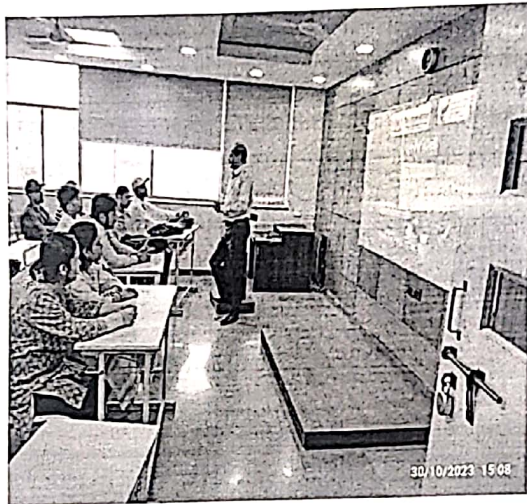
It also helps teachers personalize lessons based on their students' learning pace.
